From the Rabbi's Desk...

Rosh Hahodesh is considered quite important in pre rabbinic times. The pre rabbinic period which is sometimes perceived as the time before the destruction of the second Temple, as the Agricultural period of Jewish history. In the period of the pre destruction of the second Temple, 70.C.E, the new month, Rosh Hahodesh was practiced in some ways like a Yom Tov. That means that the New Moon was celebrated as a new beginning. Revelry and celebration like the Pilgrimage holidays of Passover, Succoth and Shavuot was similar. The prayers that were included and the offerings given at the Temple were focused on continuing good fortune or if the situation was less that ideal, prayer and offerings would include asking for change of Mazel for the new month. Celebration and revelry was always part of this special time. Our Shabbat this week brings in the New Month of Nissan, the very important month of the celebration of Passover.
